Did you know...

Currently, the majority of inmates in provincial correctional institutions are being held without bail. A large majority of individuals who are held without bail struggle with substance use disorder. These individuals are denied bail due to the risk-averse decisions made in criminal court proceedings. These risk-adverse decisions are made because there are inadequate treatment options available to address the disorder, and without treatment, the risk of re-offending is high.

Love Soluble is a Canadian non-profit and a registered charitable organization founded in 2019. Our mission is to support pre-sentenced individuals who are incarcerated due to actions influenced by substance use disorder (SUD). We aim to help our clientele achieve freedom from addiction so they can successfully reintegrate into society, ultimately reducing recidivism, addiction and homelessness.

Love Soluble operates the Manie Daniels Center, an 8-bed residential treatment facility in Maberly, Ontario. At our center, we assist our clientele in overcoming SUD while teaching essential life skills necessary for maintaining recovery beyond the confines of the criminal justice system.


Our program begins with a focus on addressing substance use disorder, followed by an assessment of other barriers that may impede your successful reintegration into society. We will work together to rebuild all areas of your life, including essential documents such as identification, banking, and your driver's license.

Next, we will support you in achieving your educational and employment goals, setting a path toward independent living. Additionally, we will guide you through navigating the court system and resolving any outstanding legal matters before the completion of your program. To ensure continued success, ongoing aftercare counseling will also be provided.

Our Treatment Program + Your Commitment

The program runs from 3 to 12 months, depending on the individualized needs.

- Client-centered treatment through care and compassion.
- Psychoeducational classroom workshops
- Spiritual-based 12-step programming in the community
- 90 meetings 90 days
- Individual/group counselling
- Leisure and recreation activities
- Life Skills Training including Education/Employment Search
- Housing Assistance/Independent Living



Joining Love Soluble – The Manie Daniels Center

At Love Soluble, we are dedicated to fostering a safe supportive, and healing environment for those on a journey to recovery. Our commitment is to offer a space where transformation and growth is encouraged.

Eligibility Criteria

All applicants must:

- Be presentenced (awaiting bail)
- Be male, 18 years of age+
- Commit to an abstinence-based lifestyle.
- Be open minded to the spiritual aspects of recovery.
- Not be charged or convicted of a sexual offense or arson.

Referral: Applicants must be referred by a recognized institutional program.

Application/Screening: Manie Daniels Center application forms will be provided through affiliated organizations. (Preliminary intake assessment form & Consent to Communicate)

Interview: An over the phone interview with Manie Daniels Center staff, including agency personnel, will be conducted.
